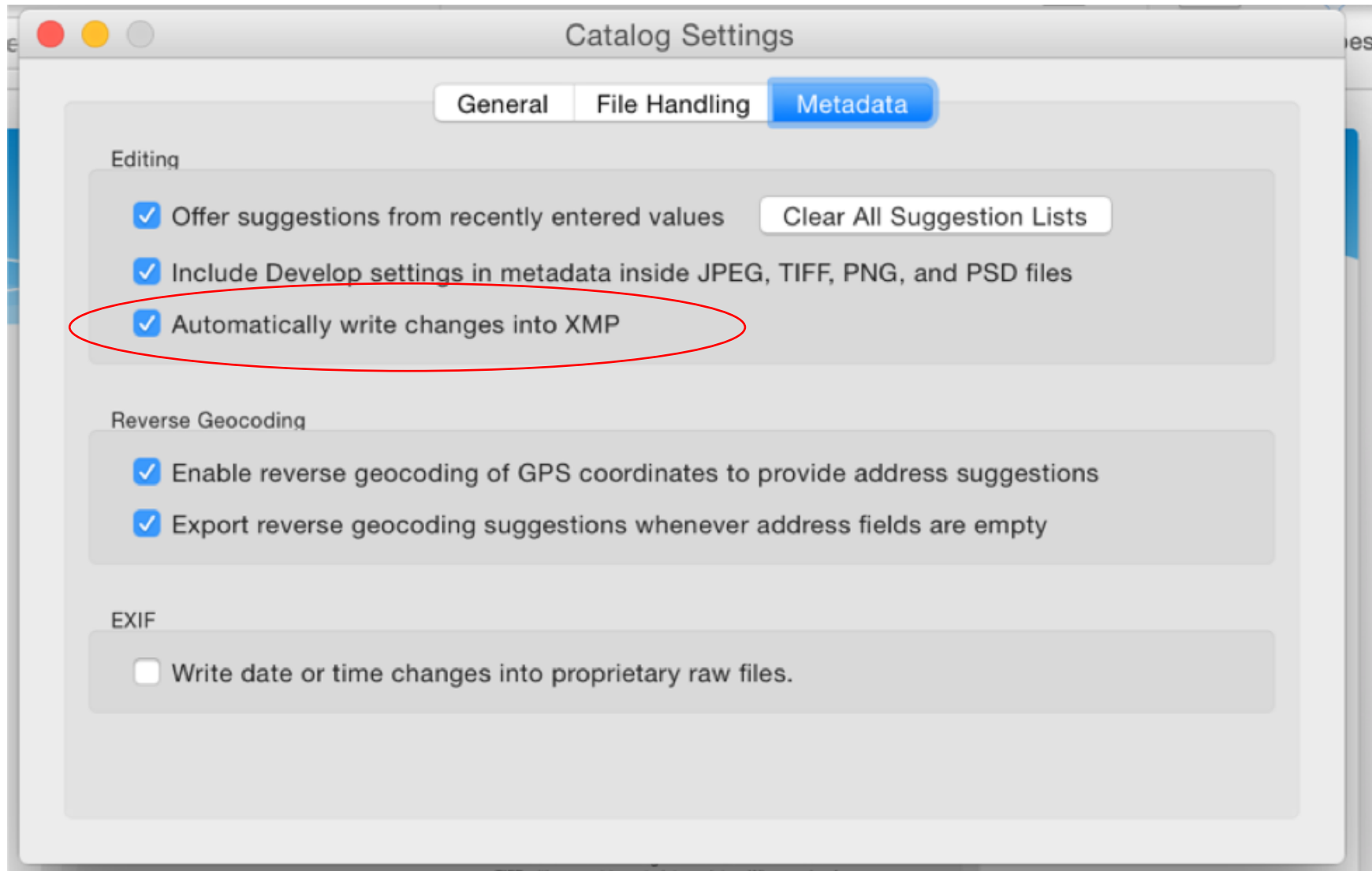

Edit in Adobe Photoshop CC 2015

File Format: PSD
Color Space: ProPhoto RGB
Bit Depth: 16 bits/component
Resolution: 240

16-bit ProPhoto RGB is the recommended choice for best preserving color details from Lightroom. PSD can be less efficient than TIFF with respect to metadata updates. When saving from Photoshop, please be sure to use the "Maximize Compatibility" option in Photoshop. Failure to do so will result in images that cannot be read by Lightroom.

8-bit files are smaller and more compatible with various programs and plug-ins, but will not preserve fine tonal detail as well as 16-bit data. The sRGB color space cannot encompass the full range of colors available within Lightroom. PSD can be less efficient than TIFF with respect to metadata updates. When saving from Photoshop, please be sure to use the "Maximize Compatibility" option in Photoshop. Failure to do so will result in images that cannot be read by Lightroom.

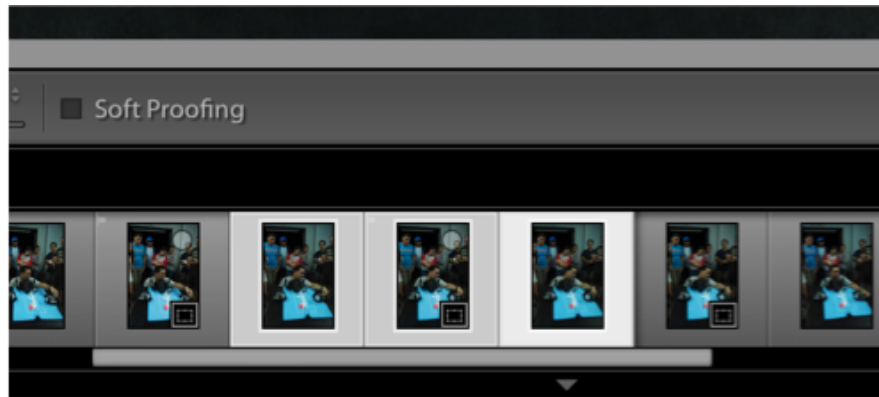

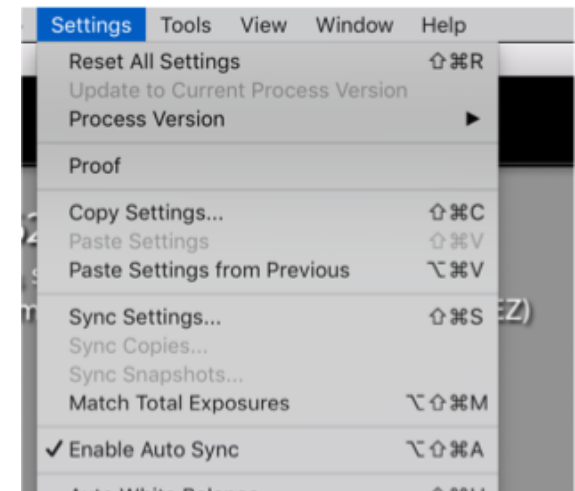
ENABLE AUTO - SYNC

This is a feature that should be set up so that you can copy-paste multiple photos at the same time

1. Go to develop mode
2. Mark multiple with shift and click right or left



3. In Settings click Enable Auto-Sync

LIGHTROOM WORKFLOW

1. Go through images rate with stars & mark **X for delete**
2. Apply standard edits with CMD C, but not too much time per photo
3. Select all 5 star photos
4. Further reduce selection by marking 4 star or less
5. Spend editing time on only 5-star images
